One evening, over a delicious dinner prepared by Mrs. Aisha, Mr. Hassan shared his concerns with the family. He explained that while he longed to give


them a permanent home, he did not want to enter into a transaction that went against their beliefs. Ali and his siblings listened intently, respecting their father's dedication to their faith.
